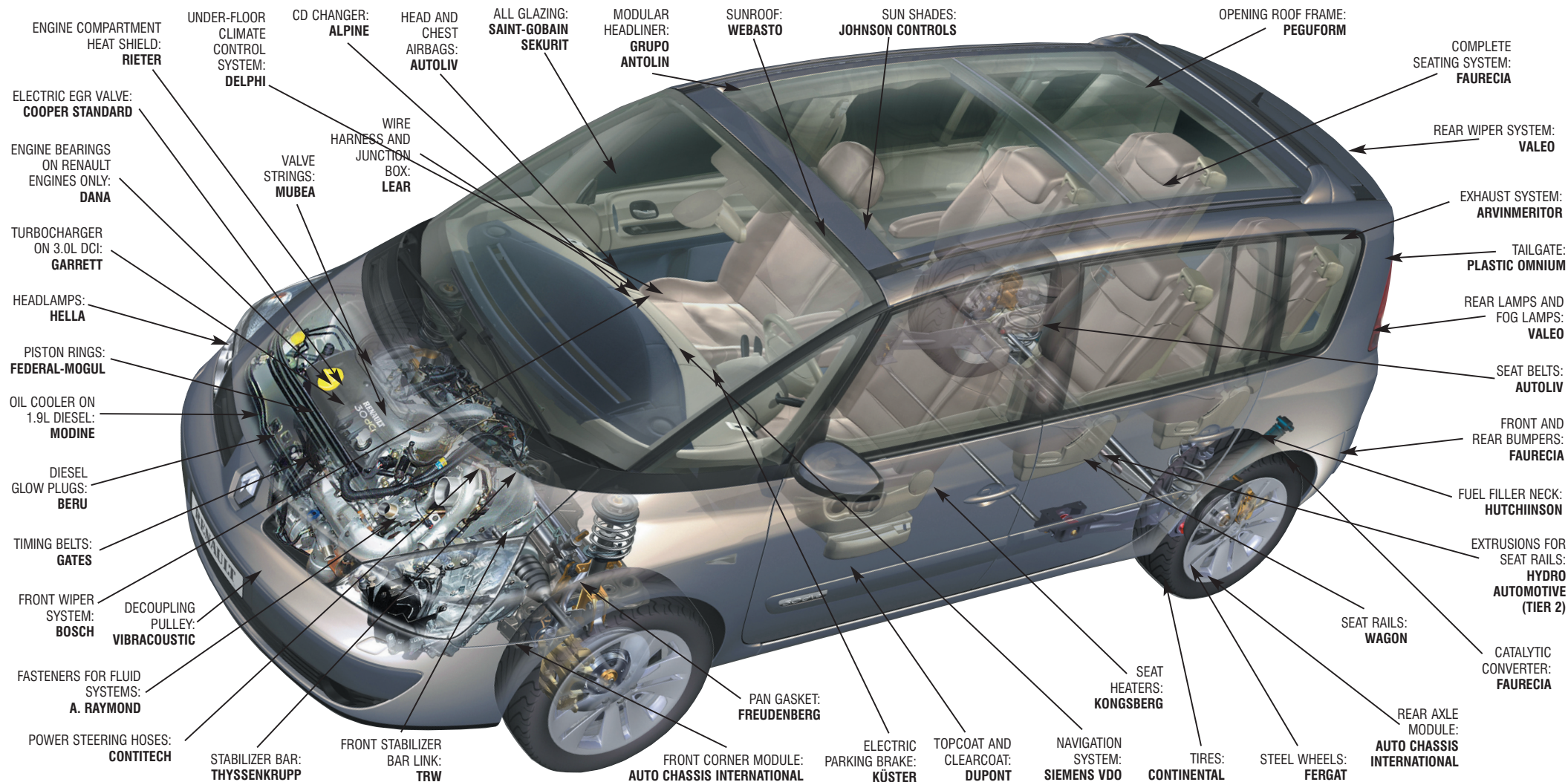


SUPPLIERS TO THE RENAULT ESPACE



RENAULT BRINGS ESPACE BACK IN-HOUSE

The new Renault Espace is built in Sandouville, France. Assembly of the outgoing Espace minivan had been outsourced to coachbuilder Matra. The old Espace captured about 20 percent of the European minivan segment, with 370,000 units sold over the product cycle. Volumes for the new model are forecast at 60,000 per

year and Renault expects to build 450,000 units in this generation. Sandouville houses several Tier 1 suppliers including Faurecia (seats), Grupo Antolin (headliner) and Lear (wire harness). Delphi's under-floor climate-control system, located mainly under the front passenger seat, is an industry first. The contract is worth €100 million to Delphi over the life of the model.
